This is a condensed form of premium list as provided for in Chapter 9, Section 2A of the AKC "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows". A list of trophies can be obtained by writing to Mary Bjelica, Show Secretary. Additionally, we will offer the **German Shepherd Dog Club of America Bronze Medal** at both specialty shows to the Best of Breed winner through the graciousness donation of the GSDC of America parent club.

Show Regulations (For Unbenched Shows)

Telegraph, Telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official entry form are not acceptable.

No entry can be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed.

Declination of entries: The German Shepherd Dog Club of Greater Raleigh Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have claim or recourse against the German Shepherd Dog Club of Greater Raleigh Inc. or any official thereof. Note, there is a 100 dog limit for this concurrent event show per AKC rules.

A recording fee of \$.50 will be required and service fee of \$1.50 for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule Chapter 14, Section 2.)

Entries will not be accepted without fees. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary.

Errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of such entries after the published closing date.

No refund for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find duplicate entries but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Show secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry will be made. The show shall be open from 9:00AM to 10:00PM. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its breed is to be judged. The show giving club and show secretary have no responsibility or obligation for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates. Any rules or regulations of civil authorities, buildings and parking restrictions must govern exhibitors. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations are subject to towing at owner's expense. Overnight camping will be allowed at the show site.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or leaser of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
